- All dogs taking part in the dog training classes do so at their own risk. The club accept no responsibility for the actions/ outcome of the dogs behaviour.
- Dig It members are expected to keep their dog(s) under control at all times.
- Instructors should be obeyed at all times to ensure the safety of the members of the club and their dog(s).
- Dig It strives to provide an instructor for every delivered class, unfortunately, due to unforeseen circumstances, this is not always possible. Dig It members therefore accept that on rare occasions they may have to self-instruct for the duration of their class where no alternative can be found.
- The members of a cancelled class are entitled to 30 minute free hire of the arena on another date and at their convenience (please book with Lydia)
- Dig it members agree to pay for any classes undertaken and/or hire of the facilities. Failure to pay for classes and/or hire will result in the suspension of the club member and, should the issue of non-payment not be resolved, removal of the club member from the club.
- Children and families are always welcome at the club but we ask that only one person takes responsibility for handling individual dogs, this is to prevent confusion to the dog, and within classes.
